## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 33:2740.67(G)" insert "and R.S. 47:338.217"
- 3 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 4 On page 1, line 4, after "board;" insert "to provide for hotel occupancy tax;"
- 5 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 3</u>
- 6 On page 2, line 20, after "<u>Parish</u>" delete "<u>may</u>" and insert "<u>shall</u>"
- 7 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- 8 On page 2, at the end of line 28, insert the following:

## 9 "Should the governing authority take action as authorized in this Paragraph to 10 collect the hotel occupancy tax, the collection shall begin no earlier than August 1, 11 2016."

- 12 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- 13 On page 3, delete lines 3 and 4 in their entirety, and insert the following:
- 14 "Section 2. R.S. 47:338.217 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
- 15 §338.217. Hotel occupancy tax in East Baton Rouge Parish

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and in addition to any other tax 16 17 now or hereafter levied and collected, the governing authority of East Baton Rouge 18 Parish, is hereby authorized and empowered to levy and collect a tax upon the paid 19 occupancy of hotel rooms located within East Baton Rouge Parish, but not located 20 within the municipalities of Baker, Central or Zachary or the area within the 21 boundaries of the Baton Rouge North Economic Development District, which are 22 hereby excepted. The hotel occupancy tax shall be two percent of the rent or fee 23 charged for such occupancy. The hotel occupancy tax shall be paid by the person who 24 exercises or is entitled to occupancy of the hotel room and shall be paid at the time the 25 rent or fee for occupancy is paid. "Person" as used herein shall have the same definition as that contained in R.S. 47:301(8). 26

27 B. The governing authority shall impose the hotel occupancy tax by ordinance 28 adopted by the governing authority which shall have the right to provide in the 29 ordinance or by resolution necessary and appropriate rules and regulations for the 30 imposition, collection, and enforcement of the hotel occupancy tax, including but not 31 limited to a provision that the initial collection of the tax shall begin on the first of a 32 month following the adoption of the ordinance levying the tax. Should the governing 33 authority take action as authorized in this Section to collect the hotel occupancy tax, 34 the collection shall begin no earlier than August 1, 2016. The ordinance levying and 35 imposing the hotel occupancy tax shall be approved by a favorable vote of a majority of the members of the governing authority present and voting. The term "ordinance" 36 37 means an ordinance, act, or other appropriate legislative enactment of the governing 38 authority.

39 C. The governing authority shall have the right to contract with the state of
40 Louisiana for the collection of the hotel occupancy tax. The tax shall be in addition to
41 all other taxes presently being levied upon the occupancy of hotel rooms in the parish.

- D. Fifty percent of the net proceeds of the tax after deduction of reasonable collection expenses shall be used to fund the Baton Rouge River Center and fifty percent of the net proceeds of the tax after deduction of reasonable collection expenses shall be used to fund Visit Baton Rouge." 1 2 3
