#### HOUSE BILL NO. 303

### BY REPRESENTATIVE LEOPOLD

AN ACT
To enact R.S. 56:303.6(D), relative to oyster harvester licenses; to provide for certain
qualifications for holding an oyster harvester license; to require successful
completion of an oyster harvester education program; and to provide for related
matters.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 56:303.6(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
§303.6. Oyster harvester license
* * *
D. Beginning in license year 2017 and thereafter, any person applying for
an oyster harvester license shall have completed the oyster harvester education
program within the previous three years. The oyster harvester education program
shall be developed by the department, promulgated under the Administrative
Procedure Act by the commission, and implemented by the department for the
purpose of developing professionalism in the oyster harvest industry. The oyster
harvester education program shall include training in the Louisiana Shellfish
Sanitation Program, Chapter 3 of Part IX of Title 51 of the Louisiana Administrative
Code, "Preparation and Handling of Seafood for Market". In addition, the oyster
harvester education program shall include best practices for conservation of the
species.
Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
