<u>Present law</u> authorizes each clerk of a district court and the Second City Court in the city of New Orleans to issue short-form birth certificate cards and long-form birth certificates and death certificates. Provides that in addition to fees collected for issuance of a birth record or death certificate, the clerk shall collect a fee of five dollars for a short-form birth certificate and nine dollars for a long-form birth certificate or death certificate.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains these provisions and provides that a short-form birth certificate card can be purchased only by as individual who also purchases a long-form birth certificate in the same transaction.

Effective upon signature of the governor or upon lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
