<u>Present law</u>, relative to the practice of addition counseling, prohibits a certified addiction counselor from practicing independently and rendering a diagnostic impression.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for exception to this prohibition and allows a certified addiction counselor to practice independently when providing addiction counseling services in a prison or other custodial environment. Retains the prohibition against rendering a diagnostic impression.
