RE NO IMPACT See Note

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Requires the Board of Regents to conduct a comprehensive review of the postsecondary needs of the state and each of its regions. (gov sig)

Proposed law requires the Board of Regents (BOR) to conduct a comprehensive review and evaluation of the educational demand of the state and its regions and provide a report to the Senate and House committees on education prior to the start of the 2017 Regular Session. Proposed law requires that the report shall include the following: 1) a description of the state's educational assets; 2) a description of the educational demands; 3) a description of the gaps; 4) recommendations on how to efficiently and cost-effectively close the gaps; 5) a discussion of the barriers to developing an integrated public postsecondary education enterprise; and 6) an executive summary of recommendations to ensure the state's public postsecondary education system is operating in a comprehensive, efficient, cost effective and integrated manner. Proposed law provides that the Department of Economic Development, the LA Workforce Commission, and each public postsecondary institution, management board, and system shall fully cooperate with the BOR and provide data and assistance as requested to the BOR in producing the report. Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
