2	To amend and reenact R.S. 27:443(B)(1)(a)(ii) and (b)(iii), relative to penalties for certain
3	violations of the Video Draw Poker Devices Control Law; to provide with respect
4	to the revocation or suspension of a license for certain violations; to provide for a
5	hearing; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 27:443(B)(1)(a)(ii) and (b)(iii) are hereby amended and reenacted
8	to read as follows:
9	§443. Allowing underage persons to play video draw poker devices; penalties;
10	revocation of license hearing
11	* * *
12	B.(1) Violations of Subsection A of this Section shall be penalized by the
13	division as follows:
14	(a) For allowing a person under the age of twenty-one to play or operate a
15	video draw poker device at a licensed establishment, unless the licensee, his
16	employee, or agent reasonably believed that the person was twenty-one years old or
17	older:
18	* * *
19	(ii) For a third or subsequent violation, <u>a</u> license revocation <u>hearing</u> shall be
20	conducted at which time the board shall determine whether or not there are
21	extenuating circumstances pursuant to which a license suspension or revocation
22	should not be imposed. At the conclusion of the hearing, the board may revoke or
23	suspend a license or impose a fine pursuant to R.S. 27:15(F).

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1 (b) For allowing a person under the age of twenty-one to play or operate a 2 video draw poker device at a licensed establishment when the licensee, his employee, 3 or agent is shown to have known or reasonably believed he was allowing a person 4 under the age of twenty-one years old to play or operate a video draw poker device, 5 or for allowing a person under the age fifteen years old to play or operate a video 6 draw poker device at a licensed establishment regardless of what the licensee, his 7 employee or agent knew or reasonably believed about the age of that person: 8 9 (iii) For a third or subsequent violation, a license revocation hearing shall be 10 conducted at which time the board shall determine whether or not there are 11 extenuating circumstances pursuant to which a license suspension or revocation 12 should not be imposed.
