1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 In Senate Committee Amendment No. 1 proposed by the Senate Committee on
3 Transportation, Highways and Public Works and adopted by the Senate on May 17, 2016,
4 on page 1, line 3, after "(B)" insert "and 863(A)(3)(a)"

6 On page 1, line 5, after "and fees;" insert "to reduce certain fees;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 In Senate Committee Amendment No. 3 proposed by the Senate Committee on
9 Transportation, Highways and Public Works and adopted by the Senate on May 17, 2016,
10 on page 1, line 8, after "(B)" insert "and 863(A)(3)(a)"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 In Senate Committee Amendment No. 4 proposed by the Senate Committee on
13 Transportation, Highways and Public Works and adopted by the Senate on May 17, 2016,
14 on page 1, line 32, after "line 1" delete the period and insert "and insert the following:

15 §863. Sanctions for false declaration; reinstatement fees; revocation of
16 registration; review

17 A. * * *

18 (3)(a) Sanctions for a violation of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection
19 shall be imposed until proof of required liability security is provided to the
20 secretary and all reinstatement fees are paid. Sanctions for a violation of
21 Paragraph (2) of this Subsection shall be imposed for a period of not less than
22 twelve months nor more than eighteen months. However, in no event shall
23 these sanctions be removed until such time as proof of the required security
24 is provided to the secretary along with all appropriate fees required by law,
25 including a reinstatement fee of one hundred dollars per violation of
26 Paragraph (1) of this Subsection if the vehicle was not covered by the
27 required security for a period of one to thirty days, two hundred fifty dollars
28 if the vehicle was not covered by required security for a period of thirty-one
29 to ninety days, and five hundred dollars if the vehicle was not covered by
30 required security for a period in excess of ninety days. Beginning on and
31 after July 1, 2017, the reinstatement fees for violations of Paragraph (1) of
32 this Subsection shall be as follows: seventy-five dollars for a first violation,
33 one hundred fifty dollars for a second violation, and three hundred dollars for
34 a third or subsequent violation. No reinstatement fee shall be imposed by the
35 secretary if the vehicle was not covered by required security for a period of
36 ten days or less and the insured surrenders the vehicle's license plate to the
37 secretary within ten days. The reinstatement fees for violations of Paragraph
38 (2) of this Subsection shall be as follows: two hundred fifty dollars for a first
39 violation, five hundred dollars for a second violation, and one thousand
40 dollars for a third or subsequent violation. The reinstatement fee shall not be
41 owed for an alleged violation of Paragraph (2) of this Subsection when proof
42 of the required security is provided to the secretary within sixty days of the
43 date of the notice. If at the time of reinstatement, a person has multiple
44 violations and is within sixty days of the notice, the total amount of fees to

1 be paid shall not exceed eight hundred fifty dollars, for violations of
2 Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, or one thousand seventy-five dollars for
3 violations of Paragraph (2) of this Subsection. At no time shall the total
4 amount of fees, including administrative fees, exceed two hundred fifty
5 dollars for persons sixty-five years or older. After sixty days of the date of
6 the notice, all fees shall be considered final delinquent debt and therefore
7 owed, and the eight hundred fifty dollar limit for persons under sixty-five
8 years shall no longer apply. Beginning on and after July 1, 2017, if at the
9 time of reinstatement, a person has multiple violations and is within sixty
10 days of the notice, the total amount of fees to be paid shall not exceed six
11 hundred fifty dollars, for violations of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, or
12 one thousand seventy-five dollars for violations of Paragraph (2) of this
13 Subsection. At no time shall the total amount of fees, including
14 administrative fees, exceed two hundred fifty dollars for persons sixty-five
15 years or older. Beginning on and after July 1, 2017, after sixty days of the
16 date of the notice, all fees shall be considered final delinquent debt and
17 therefore owed, and the six hundred fifty dollar limit for persons under sixty-
18 five years shall no longer apply.

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
