13	(7) As it relates to the parish of St. Tammany, all of the following shall apply

15	(c)(i) When a patient is transferred from another parish pursuant to an
16	emergency certificate, a second physician's emergency certificate may, when
17	appropriate, shall be executed by a physician at the admitting facility.
18	* * *
19	(8) As it relates to the parishes of East Baton Rouge, Jefferson, Orleans
20	and Ouachita, the following shall apply:
21	(a) When a patient is transferred from another parish pursuant to an
22	emergency certificate, a second physician's emergency certificate, when
23	appropriate, shall be executed by a physician at the admitting facility.
