<u>Prior law</u> authorized the clerk of court in Jefferson Parish to demand and receive (in addition to other fees fixed by law in criminal cases):

- (1) A \$2 processing fee for an extension of time granted for payment of a fine for a traffic ticket.
- (2) A \$7.50 fee for every attachment issued to bring witnesses, summons, subpoenas, and court orders for arrest.

New law retains prior law.

<u>Prior law</u> also authorized the clerk of court in Jefferson Parish to demand and receive a \$100 filing and processing fee for all felony expungement proceedings filed in the 24th JDC and a \$50 filing and processing fee for all misdemeanor expungement proceedings filed in the 24th JDC and the First and Second Parish Courts for the parish of Jefferson.

New law repeals prior law.

Effective August 1, 2016.
