R.S. 32:668(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 8 §668. Procedure following revocation or denial of license; hearing; court review; 9 review of final order; restricted licenses 10 11 C.(1) After a person has exhausted his remedies with the department, he 12 shall have the right to file a petition in the appropriate court for a review of the final 13 order of suspension or denial by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections in 14 the same manner and under the same conditions as is provided in R.S. 32:414 in the 15 cases of suspension, revocation, and cancellation of licenses. The court in its review 16 of the final order of suspension or denial by the Department of Public Safety and 17 Corrections may exercise any action it deems necessary under the law including 18 ordering the department to grant the person restricted non-commercial driving 19 privileges where appropriate as provided in Subsection B of this Section. 20 (2) Upon filing a petition for review, the licensee shall serve the Department 21 of Public Safety and Corrections with a copy of the petition and summons. Upon 22 receipt of a copy of the petition for review, the department shall issue the licensee 23 driving privileges, which shall be valid until the decision on the petition for review

AN ACT

1	is final. The court on its own motion, or on the motion of either party, may modify
2	or vacate such driving privileges upon a showing of good cause.
