Provides relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages by persons under the age of 18

<u>Proposed law</u> enacts R.S.14.93.12.1 relative to the unlawful possession of alcoholic beverages and crime prohibiting possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages by a person under eighteen years of age. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for exceptions, criminal penalties, and related matters. <u>Proposed law</u> provides penalties of a fine of not more than \$25 for a first offense and a fine of not more than \$100 for any subsequent offense.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on state governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The <u>proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in local funds revenue as result of potential fines. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for a fine of not more than \$25 for a first offense and not more than \$100 for any subsequent offense, if certain persons under eighteen years of age unlawfully "possess" or consume alcoholic beverages as a result of not being in the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian who is twenty-one years of age or older. The potential revenue will accrue to the local governing authority.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> for a maximum \$100 fine for any person under twenty-one years of age convicted of unlawful purchase or have "public possession" of any alcoholic beverage.
