## **DIGEST**

<u>Present law</u> provides for methods of source selection that may be utilized by state agencies to satisfy a state goal for contracting with veteran and service-connected disabled veteranowned small entrepreneurships.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes 10% of the total evaluation points in a request for proposal to be awarded to an offeror who is a certified veteran and service-connected disabled veteranowned small business entrepreneurship.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> relative to awarding 10% of the total evaluation points to certain veterans <u>from</u> permissive <u>to</u> mandatory.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it shall not apply to design-build or construction manager at risk methods of construction.
