## HB 1134 2016 Regular Session Hazel

MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Requires the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to issue an economic hardship license under certain circumstances

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to issue an economic hardship license for a period of one year or until such time as the individual has paid or made payment arrangements, as described in present law, instead of for a period of two years.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles from issuing an economic hardship license to a person whose driver's license is suspended and has not been renewed because of delinquent state taxes.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by requiring the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to issue an economic hardship license to a person whose driver's license is suspended and has not been renewed because of delinquent state taxes. Specifies that the economic hardship license is valid for a period of one year or until such time as the individual has paid or made payment arrangements relative to his state tax delinquency.
