2	To enact R.S. 14:108(B)(1)(e), relative to the crime of resisting an officer; to add the
3	knowing interference with a police cordon to the definition of "obstruction of" an
4	officer; to provide additional definitions; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:108(B)(1)(e) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§108. Resisting an officer
8	* * *
9	B.(1) The phrase "obstruction of" as used herein shall, in addition to its
10	common meaning, signification, and connotation mean the following:
11	* * *
12	(e) Knowing interference with a police cordon resulting from the
13	intentional crossing or traversing of a police cordon by an unauthorized person
14	or an unmanned aircraft system (UAS). The cordoned area includes the
15	airspace above the cordoned area.
16	(i) For purposes of this Subparagraph, "police cordon" means any
17	impediment or structure erected or established by an officer for crowd or traffic
18	control, or to prevent or obstruct the passage of a person at the scene of a crime
19	or investigation.
20	(ii) "Impediment or structure" includes but is not limited to crime scene
21	tape, rope, cable, wire or metal barricades, or the posting of uniformed officers
22	or other personnel otherwise identifiable as law enforcement officers.
23	(iii) "Unmanned aircraft system" shall have the same meaning as
24	provided by R.S. 14:337(B).

1 (iv) If the flight of a UAS into the cordoned area endangers the public or
2 an officer's safety, law enforcement personnel or fire department personnel are
3 authorized to disable the UAS.
