HB 882 2016 Regular Session Armes

PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS: Provides for the percentage of total evaluation points awarded to certain veterans in requests for proposals for state procurements and public contracts

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Prohibits application of <u>proposed law</u> to requests for proposals for design-build or construction manager at risk methods of construction.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides for methods of source selection that may be utilized by state agencies to satisfy a state goal for contracting with veteran and service-connected disabled veteranowned small entrepreneurships.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes 10% of the total evaluation points in a request for proposal to be awarded to an offeror who is a certified veteran and service-connected disabled veteranowned small business entrepreneurship.

<u>Proposed law changes present law relative to awarding 10% of the total evaluation points to certain veterans from permissive to mandatory.</u> Further prohibits the mandatory award of evaluation points to certain veterans for requests for proposals for design-build or construction manager at risk methods of construction.

Effective Aug. 1, 2016.
