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Provides relative to school bus inspection fees

<u>Present law</u> provides that fees for personal motor vehicles inspections are \$10. <u>Present law</u> regarding fees associated with personal motor vehicle inspections applies to inspections of student transportation vehicles (i.e. school buses). <u>Proposed law</u> increases inspection fees for student transportation vehicles to \$20 on January 1, 2017. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for the disposition of fees for student transportation vehicle inspections. <u>Proposed law</u> states that the adjustment of headlights for student transportation vehicles shall be included in the inspection at no additional cost. <u>Proposed law</u> states that the legislature recognizes that a student transportation vehicle inspection in more extensive than that of a personal motor vehicle, and that the fee increases are based on the differences in the two inspections.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will increase expenditures for local governing authorities by \$10 per school bus to the extent they own school buses and get them inspected by a third party. Presently school buses may be inspected by a third party or by employees of local governing authorities trained and authorized to perform school bus inspections. Proposed law increases the fee for school bus inspections by \$10, from \$10 to \$20. For reference, the Office of Motor Vehicles reports that 3,855 school buses have active registrations statewide, but does not know how many are owned by local governing authorities.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure. Proposed law retains present law allowing the Office of Motor Vehicles to retain \$1.25 and the Office of State Police to retain \$4 for each school bus inspection performed, the same amount both entities presently retain for school bus inspections.
