- (b) (ii) Methods of management of the collaborative practice which shall include clinical practice guidelines.
- (c) (iii) Coverage of the health care needs of a patient during any absence of the advanced practice registered nurse, physician, or dentist.
- (b) A collaborative practice agreement shall not be required after January 1, 2018, if the advanced practice registered nurse is exempt pursuant to the rules and regulations adopted by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing and the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners in accordance with R.S. 37:914.1 and R.S. 1263.1 and promulgated and published pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act.
