5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:	
6	§67.30. Theft of animals	
7	A. Except as provided in R.S. 3:2654, theft of animals is the	
8	misappropriation, killing, or taking of any animal which belongs to another,	
9	either without consent of the other to the misappropriation or taking, or by	
10	means of fraudulent conduct, practices, or representations. An intent to deprive	
11	the other permanently of the animal or an intent to ransom it for the purpose	
12	of extorting money or favor is essential.	
13	B. Whoever commits the crime of theft of animals shall be imprisoned	
14	for not more than six months or fined not more than five hundred dollars or	
15	both. If the offender in such a case has been convicted of misdemeanor theft of	
16	an animal two or more times previously, upon any subsequent conviction he	
17	shall be imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for not more than two years or	
18	may be fined not more than one thousand dollars, or both.	
19	C. For the purposes of this Section, "animal" means any nonhuman	
20	living creature except for livestock as defined in R.S. 14:67.1.
