2	To amend and reenact R.S. 32:1(1.1), 190(D), 401(2), and 408(C)(3), relative to autocycles;
3	to amend the definition of autocycle applicable to operators and passengers for a
4	helmet exemption; to amend the definition of autocycle applicable for an exemption
5	for certain driver's license endorsements for operators; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 32:1(1.1), 190(D), 401(2), and 408(C)(3) are hereby amended and
9	reenacted to read as follows:
10	§1. Definitions
11	When used in this Chapter, the following words and phrases have the
12	meanings ascribed to them in this Section, unless the context clearly indicates a
13	different meaning:

15	(1.1)(a) "Autocycle" means an enclosed motorcycle that is equipped with
16	safety belts, rollbar or roll cage, windshield wipers, steering wheel, and equipment
17	otherwise required on a motorcycle and that has no more than three wheels in contact
18	with the roadway at any one time a three-wheeled motorcycle on which the driver
19	and all passengers ride in either a completely enclosed seating area or in a side-
20	by-side seating area that is equipped with a rollbar or roll cage, safety belts for
21	all occupants, and is designed to be controlled with a steering wheel and pedals.
22	(b) For purposes of this Paragraph, "rollbar" or "roll cage" shall mean a
23	hardtop enclosure protecting occupants from the elements supports that will support
24	bear the vehicle's weight and is are so designed as to protect the occupants when the

3	§190. Safety helmets

5	D. This Section does not apply to a person operating or riding in an autocycle
6	if the vehicle is equipped with a roof supports that meets meet or exceeds exceed

8	Subsection, "rollbar" or "roll cage" shall mean a hardtop enclosure protecting
9	occupants from the elements supports that will support bear the vehicle's weight

14	The following words and phrases when used in this Chapter shall have the
15	meaning herein assigned unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

17	(2)(a) "Autocycle" means a three-wheeled motorcycle on which the driver
18	and all passengers ride in <u>either</u> a completely enclosed seating area <u>or in a side-by-</u>
19	side seating area that is equipped with a rollbar or roll cage, safety belts for all
20	occupants, airbag protection, antilock brakes, and is designed to be controlled with
21	a steering wheel and pedals.
22	(b) For purposes of this Paragraph, "rollbar" or "roll cage" shall mean a
23	hardtop enclosure protecting occupants from the elements supports that will support
24	<b>bear</b> the vehicle's weight and is <b>are</b> so designed as to protect the occupants when the
25	vehicle is resting on this enclosure the supports.

2 autocycles as defined by R.S. 32:401(24) 32:401(2). As such, the operation of an
3 autocycle shall not require a special endorsement but shall only require require only
