| 6 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: |
| 7 | Section 1. R.S. 14:71.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows: |
| 8 | §71.4. Homestead exemption fraud |
| 9 | A. It is unlawful for any person to intentionally claim more than one |
| 10 | homestead exemption as provided for in Article VII, Section 20 of the Louisiana |
| 11 | Constitution. |
| 12 | B. Any person who intentionally claims more than one homestead exemption |
| 13 | shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars, imprisoned for not more than six |
| 14 | months, or both. |
| 15 | C. In addition to the penalties provided in Subsection B of this Section, a |
| 16 | person convicted of a violation of this Section shall be ordered to make full |
| 17 | restitution to the state or local governmental subdivision which has suffered a |
| 18 | financial loss as a result of the offense. If a person ordered to make restitution |
| 19 | pursuant to this Section is found to be indigent and therefore unable to make |
| 20 | restitution in full at the time of conviction, the court shall order a periodic payment |
| 21 | plan consistent with the person's financial ability. |
