1	Section 2. R.S. 56:1688(E) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
2	§1688. Park wardens; powers and duties

4	E. State park wardens shall successfully complete a basic certified
5	training program approved by the Council on Peace Officer Standards and
6	Training as provided by R.S. 40:2405 and shall fulfill all requirements for
7	annual basic firearms training.
8	Section 3. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2017.
