Subject: Increases the Admin. Fee for Safe Drinking Water Program

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Increases the safe drinking water administration fee

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the administration fee for the Safe Drinking Water Program from \$3.20 (water systems retain \$0.32) to \$12 (water systems retain 5% of fee, which is \$0.60). <u>Proposed law</u> provides that water systems shall collect the \$12 fee in at least quarterly installments from customers and remitted in quarterly payments to OPH. <u>Proposed law</u> requires that the fee revenue shall be used as follows: (1) comply with the federal Safe Drinking Water Act; (2) fund up to 40 sanitarian positions within the Safe Drinking Water Program within the Office of Public Health (OPH); and (3) \$500,000 to the LA Rural Water Association, a non-profit organization. <u>Proposed law</u> renames the administration fee the "Safe Drinking Water Fee". <u>Proposed law</u> shall be effective on January 1, 2017.

### **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation requires all revenue generated from the fee increase to be used by the Office of Public Health (OPH) as follows: (1) comply with the federal Safe Drinking Water Act; (2) fund up to 40 sanitarian positions within the Safe Drinking Water Program within the Office of Public Health (OPH); and (3) transfer \$500,000 to the LA Rural Water Association. The annual cost of a sanitarian position is approximately \$96,000 (\$65,000 average salary plus \$31,000 related benefits).

### **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

#### Office of Public Health

The proposed legislation increases Fees and Self-Generated Revenues by \$6,730,800 in FY 17 and \$13,461,600 in subsequent fiscal years within the Department of Health & Hospitals, Office of Public Health (OPH). The proposed legislation increases the existing administration fee of the Safe Water Drinking Program from \$3.20 (water systems retain \$0.32) to \$12 (water systems retain 5%, which is \$0.60) beginning January 1, 2017. # **Public Water Systems**

The proposed legislation increases the Safe Water Drinking Program administration fee retained by water systems from \$0.32 to 5%, which is \$0.60. To the extent some of the 1,341 water systems are owned by local governmental units, the \$0.28 fee increase is anticipated to increase local revenues by an indeterminable amount.
