<u>Existing law</u> requires a coroner or person performing the duties of coroner to present a report to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and to the La. Hwy. Safety Commission regarding the death of any person as a result of an accident involving a motor vehicle and the circumstances surrounding the death.

Prior law required the report to be presented within five days.

<u>New law</u> changes <u>prior law</u> by increasing the time period for reporting <u>from</u> five days <u>to</u> 60 days. <u>New law</u> also modifies <u>prior law</u> by replacing the word "accident" with "collision".

<u>Prior law</u> required every hospital to notify the coroner of the parish in which it is located of any death occurring in the hospital resulting from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident.

New law removes this prior law notification requirement.

Effective August 1, 2016.
