## ACT 213 (HB 172) 2016 Regular Session Jefferson

<u>Existing law</u> provides that a person who has had his probation revoked for a first technical violation shall be required to serve a sentence of not more than 90 days.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that this 90-day sentence shall be served without diminution of sentence or credit for time served prior to the revocation for the technical violation.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> providing that the 90-day sentence shall be served without diminution of sentence, but changes <u>prior law</u> to provide that the defendant shall be given credit for time served prior to the revocation hearing for time served in actual custody while being held for a technical violation in a local detention facility, state institution, or out-of-state institution.

Effective August 1, 2016.
