## ACT 67 (HB 616) 2016 Regular Session Henry

Appropriates funds for FY 2016-2017 for the ordinary operating expenses of the judicial branch of government with total funding of \$163,655,352 from the following sources: \$143,855,017 out of the State General Fund (Direct); \$9,392,850 through interagency transfers from the Dept. of Children and Family Services; and, \$10,407,485 from statutory dedications out of the Judges' Supplemental Compensation Fund and the Trial Court Case Management Fund.

Funding for the ordinary operating expenses of the judicial branch of government is provided as follows:

Provides that the appropriations out of the State General Fund (Direct) contained in this Act shall be reduced by a total amount of \$23,058,240 pursuant to a plan adopted by the Judicial Budgetary Control Board or as approved by the La. Supreme Court. This reduction of the appropriations in the Act will bring the total budget to \$163,655,352. Prohibits such adopted plan from impacting the funding for legal representation of children in child protection cases.
