<u>Existing law</u> provides relative to genetic information, including various requirements for and restrictions on the use of such information by health insurers. Also provides for exceptions from <u>existing law</u>.

<u>New law</u> additionally provides that the requirements of <u>existing law</u> shall not apply to genetic information obtained:

- (1) For treatment, payment, and healthcare operations by an insurer consistent with the federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and its related regulations.
- (2) For maintenance of information by an insurer in accordance with record retention requirements.

Effective August 1, 2016.
