<u>Prior law</u> provided that a recorded privilege against a condominium parcel preserved the right to file suit for one year from the date of recordation.

 $\underline{\text{New law}}$ extends the privilege to file suit against a condominium parcel $\underline{\text{from}}$ one year $\underline{\text{to}}$ five years from the date of recordation.

<u>New law</u> requires the condominium association to pay attorney fees and all associated costs if the condominium association files a lien for dues not owed which in turn requires an owner or interest holder to file suit to have the lien or privilege released.

Effective August 1, 2016.
