<u>New law</u> prohibits any person from knowingly giving or placing on any bail bond or declaration of residence false, nonexistent, or incomplete information for purposes of service or notice.

<u>New law</u> provides criminal penalties for misdemeanor cases including imprisonment for not more than six months, a fine of not more than \$500, or both. For felonies, the criminal penalties include imprisonment at hard labor for not more than two years.
