<u>Existing law</u> provides that a city court having jurisdiction may impose a service charge not to exceed \$10 per filing, which shall be paid to the clerk of court at the time of filing.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that all monies collected in accordance with <u>existing law</u> shall be forwarded to the court and placed in an account dedicated exclusively to the acquisition, leasing, construction, equipping, and maintenance of new and existing city courts and for the maintenance and payment of any bond indebtedness on any such existing facilities.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and further provides that the <u>existing law</u> term "equipping" includes all costs associated with new and existing software and electronic case management systems for court use.

Effective upon signature of the governor (May 26, 2016).
