Existing law provides for the creation of Veterans Court probation programs in district courts.

<u>New law</u> provides that, with the consent of the district attorney, the court may defer proceedings and place a defendant on probation when the court determines that it is in the best interest of justice.

<u>New law</u> provides that once the term of probation is completed, the criminal charges shall be dismissed against the person.

<u>New law</u> further provides that the dismissal of charges shall be without court adjudication of guilt, not be deemed a conviction, and shall only occur once with respect to any person.

<u>New law</u> also provides that if the defendant is accepted into the Veterans Court program, the defendant must waive the right to trial.

Effective August 1, 2016.
