<u>Existing law</u> provides for procedures for the interdiction of certain persons. In the judgment of interdiction, <u>existing law</u> requires the court to appoint a curator and undercurator, state when the powers of curator commence, and direct the clerk of court to record the judgment.

<u>New law</u> adds the requirement that judgments of interdiction include the defendant's name, domicile, age, and current address.
