Existing law provides for the operation of video draw poker devices at qualified truck stops.

<u>Prior law</u> required the La. Gaming Control Board to revoke the license to operate video draw poker devices for a third or subsequent violation of allowing a person under the age of 21 to play or operate a video draw poker device at a licensed establishment.

<u>New law</u> amends <u>prior law</u> to remove the automatic revocation penalty for a third or subsequent offense and provides for a hearing to be conducted by the Gaming Control Board to determine if extenuating circumstances are present pursuant to which a license suspension or revocation should not be imposed.

<u>New law</u> provides that at the conclusion of the hearing, the board may revoke or suspend a license or impose a fine on the licensee pursuant to <u>existing law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2016.
