<u>Existing law</u> provides a child support guideline schedule which is based on economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> but incorporates the most recent economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

<u>Prior law</u> provided monthly basic child support obligations for combined adjusted monthly gross incomes beginning with \$0 per month.

<u>New law</u> amends the monthly basic child support obligations and utilizes \$0-\$900 as the minimum adjusted monthly gross income.

<u>Prior law</u> provided a ceiling of \$30,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

<u>New law</u> amends <u>prior law</u> by raising the ceiling <u>from</u> \$30,000 <u>to</u> \$40,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

Effective August 1, 2016.
