Existing law authorizes an automobile expense allowance for the assessor in Webster Parish payable out of existing funds of the assessor's office, provided the assessor maintains \$300,000 of automobile insurance per accident for bodily injury and \$100,000 of automobile insurance per accident for bodily injury and \$100,000 of automobile insurance per accident for property damage.

Prior law authorized the allowance equal to 15% of the assessor's annual salary.

<u>New law</u> adds authorization for the assessors in Assumption, Iberville, and Pointe Coupee parishes to have an automobile expense allowance as provided for in <u>existing</u> and <u>new law</u>.

<u>New law</u> adds a limitation for the assessors in Webster, Assumption, Iberville, and Pointe Coupee parishes that the amount of the expense allowance shall not exceed 15% of the assessor's annual salary and that the expense allowance be funded by the assessor at no additional expense to the state or local governing authority.

Effective August 1, 2016.
