<u>Prior law</u> authorized the commissioner to issue an additional hang tag to a person with a mobility impairment if that person was dependent on both parents who are divorced and residing in separate households.

<u>New law</u> modifies <u>prior law</u> by authorizing the commissioner to issue up to three additional hang tags on behalf of any person with a mobility impairment, instead of solely to mobility impaired dependents of divorced parents residing in separate households.

Effective August 1, 2016.
