Existing law authorizes parish custodians of voting machines to appoint deputies to help them with their duties. Places certain limitations on who may qualify to serve as a deputy and ascribes certain duties to the position.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that a deputy parish custodian of voting machines was to be paid \$75 for each election at which he served. <u>New law</u> increases this amount to \$100 for each election.

Effective August 1, 2016.
