<u>Existing law</u> creates the La. Energy and Power Authority as a political subdivision of the state for the purpose of providing facilities for the generation and transmission of electric power and energy.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that the La. Energy and Power Authority is governed by a board of directors and provides for terms of the members of such board. Requires directors to be U.S. citizens domiciled in La.

<u>Prior law</u> required directors to be domiciled in the municipality represented. <u>New law</u> provides that a director shall be an employee of or domiciled in the municipality.

Effective August 1, 2016.
