<u>New law</u> creates the "Bronze Star Medal" license plate for the recipients of the Bronze Star Medal and provides for the use, name, fee, design, and specifications of the speciality plate.

<u>New law</u> restricts the use of the license plate to passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

<u>New law</u> requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to develop and adopt rules relative to the implementation of the speciality plate including the transfer of the license plate to the surviving spouse and the disposition of the speciality plate.

<u>New law</u> allows any applicant who qualifies for the military honor license plate to be issued a plate for each vehicle registered in the applicant's name.

Effective August 1, 2016.
