<u>Present constitution</u> authorizes the State Board of Commerce and Industry, with gubernatorial approval, to enter into contracts to exempt new and expanding manufacturing facilities from ad valorem taxation.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> retains the ability of the board to enter into contracts to exempt certain manufacturing facilities from certain ad valorem taxes.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> beginning January 1, 2019, prohibits the board from exempting a manufacturing facility under a new contract or contract renewal from the payment of ad valorem taxes imposed by or on behalf of a city, parish, or other local public school board.

Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 6, 2018.
