<u>Present law</u> provides for the Louisiana Tax Free Shopping Program, authorizing a sales tax refund program for certain purchases by international travelers.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law is effective through July 1, 2017.

Proposed law extends the program through July 1, 2023.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
