<u>Present law</u> allows local school boards discretion in the use of corporal punishment for students and requires the boards to adopt rules and regulations to implement and control its use.

<u>Proposed law prohibits</u> the administration of corporal punishment to students with exceptionalities, except gifted and talented students, and makes <u>present law</u> and <u>proposed law</u> applicable to charter schools.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
