White

<u>Present law</u> provides for prohibited uses on certain rivers in the Louisiana Scenic Rivers Act. Further provides that the prohibited uses are channelization, clearing and snagging, channel realignment, and reservoir construction.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows for the permitting of clearing and snagging, and dredging operations for drainage purposes, in Comite River, Amite River, and Bayou Manchac.
