AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 23:1553(G), relative to the Incumbent Worker Training
3	Program; to extend the termination date of the fund; and to provide for related
4	matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 23:1553(G) is hereby amended and reacted to read as follows:
7	§1553. Noncharging of benefits; recoupment; social charge account; social charge
8	tax rate
9	* * *
10	G. The Incumbent Worker Training Program reauthorization shall be
11	expressly renewed by the legislature prior to July 1, 2018 2020, in order for amounts
12	to be charged and credited to the Incumbent Worker Training Account in the
13	following calendar year for use in funding the program.
14	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become

1 effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a special fund within the Employment Security Administration Fund (i.e. the fund in which employers deposit their unemployment insurance taxes).

<u>Present law</u> provides that moneys from the special fund are to be used only for the purpose of upgrading employee job skills through training.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the Incumbent Worker Training Program reauthorization shall be expressly renewed by the legislature prior to July 1, 2018, in order for amounts to be charged and credited to the Incumbent Worker Training Account in the following calendar year for use in funding the program.

<u>Proposed law</u> extends the authorization of the Incumbent Worker Training Program $\underline{\text{from}}$ July 1, 2018, $\underline{\text{to}}$ July 1, 2020.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
