HIGHWAYS: Authorizes the Regional Transit Authority to solicit and enter into publicprivate partnership contracts

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 48:1660.1, relative to the Regional Transit Authority; to authorize the use of
3	public-private partnership contracts by the authority for certain projects; to provide
4	for procedure; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 48:1660.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1660.1. Public-private partnership projects
8	A. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary or the requirements of this Part,
9	if the board of commissioners determine it is in the best interest of the taxpayers, the
10	Regional Transit Authority, with approval of the House and Senate transportation,
11	highways, and public works committees, may solicit proposals for and enter into
12	contracts for public-private partnership projects for a transportation facility, provided
13	the authority shall comply with the provisions of R.S. 48:2084 through 2084.15 that
14	are applicable to public-private partnership projects of the Louisiana Transportation
15	Authority. However, R.S. 48:256.3 and 48:256.5 shall be applicable in the same
16	manner as any other department projects.
17	B. The authority shall not receive an unsolicited proposal for a public-private
18	partnership project.
19	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
20	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

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Abstract: Authorizes the Regional Transit Authority to solicit and enter into public-private partnership contracts under certain circumstances.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) to solicit proposals for and enter into contracts for public-private partnership projects for a transportation facility, provided the authority complies with <u>present law</u> applicable to public-private partnership projects of the La. Transportation Authority when the commissioners of the RTA determine a public-private partnership is in the best interest of taxpayers and receives approval from the House and Senate transportation, highways, and public works committees.

<u>Proposed law</u> makes <u>present law</u> provisions relative to the payment of a bond and the process for the payment of the claim of a contractor applicable in the same manner as any other department projects.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the RTA from receiving an unsolicited proposal for a public-private partnership project.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
