Abstract: Repeals the authorization for state tax exemption contracts to be granted by the Board of Commerce and Industry for manufacturing establishments, warehousing and distribution establishments, and corporate headquarters.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the Board of Commerce and Industry to grant exemptions from the following state taxes: corporation franchise, corporation income, sales and use, and any other tax imposed by the state to which a business may be subject. Exemptions are granted through contracts between the Board of Commerce and Industry and certain eligible types of businesses which include: manufacturing establishments, corporate headquarters, and warehousing and distribution establishments.

<u>Present law</u> gives broad authorization for the establishment of criteria and requirements for exemptions through administrative rules.

Proposed law repeals present law.
