1	AN ACT
2	To provide relative to special treasury funds; to provide for the transfer, deposits, and use
3	as specified of certain treasury funds; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer
7	is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$25,000,000 into the Budget Stabilization Fund
8	from the state general fund.
9	Section 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer
10	is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$7,582,927 into the Self-Insurance Fund from
11	the Future Medical Care Fund.
12	Section 3. Sections 1, 3, and 4 of this Act shall become effective upon signature of
13	this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for
14	bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section
15	18 of the Constitution of Louisiana.
16	Section 4. Section 2 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2017.

Abstract: Provides for the transfer, deposit, and use of monies among state funds.

<u>Proposed law</u>, effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action, transfers \$25 million into the Budget Stabilization Fund from the state general fund.

<u>Proposed law</u>, effective July 1, 2017, transfers \$7,582,927 into the Self-Insurance Fund from the Future Medical Care Fund.
