PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS: Provides relative to advertisements and bids for the lease of public lands

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 41:1214(B) and to enact R.S. 41:1214(E), relative to the
3	advertisement and bids for the lease of public land; to provide relative to the delivery
4	and acceptance of bids; to provide for a uniform and secure electronic interactive
5	system for submittal of public works bids; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 41:1214(B) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 41:1214(E)
8	is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§1214. Advertisement and bids
10	* * *
11	B. The lessor may on its own initiative advertise for bids for any lease as
12	provided herein but without application therefor. The applications and bids provided
13	for in this Part shall be secret, sealed applications and bids. and shall be forwarded
14	through the United States mail to the lessor at its domiciled address. Each bid shall
15	be either hand delivered by the bidder, or his agent, in which instance the deliverer
16	shall receive a written receipt, or such bid shall be sent by registered or certified mail
17	with a return receipt requested, or shall be submitted electronically as provided in
18	Subsection E of this Section. No public entity shall accept or take any bids,
19	including receiving any hand delivered bids, on days which are recognized as
20	holidays by the United States Postal Service.

1	E. Public entities shall provide a uniform and secure electronic interactive
2	system as an additional bidding option for the submittal of bids for public works
3	requiring competitive bidding. Any public entity providing such system shall follow
4	the standards for the receipt of electronic bids adopted by the office of the governor,
5	the division of administration, and the office of technology services as provided for
6	in LAC 4:XV.701. Any special condition or requirement for the submission shall be
7	specified in the advertisement for bids required by this Section.
8	(1) Public entities that are currently without available high speed internet
9	access shall be exempt from the provisions of this Subsection until such time that
10	high speed internet access becomes available.
11	(2) Any parish with a police jury form of government and a population of
12	less than twenty thousand people shall be exempt from the provisions of this
13	Subsection.
14	(3) Any local governmental subdivision with a population of less than ten
15	thousand people shall be exempt from the provisions of this Subsection.
16	(4) Any other public entity which is unable to comply with the electronic
17	bidding provisions of this Subsection without securing and expending additional
18	funding shall be exempt from the requirements of this Subsection.
19	(5) Public entities shall have the option to require that all bids be submitted
20	electronically for any competitive bid let out for public bid.
21	(6) Public entities shall include all information regarding the advertisement
22	of bids described in Subsection A of this Section.

Leopold

Abstract: Provides for advertisement and electronic submittal procedures for the lease of public lands.

<u>Present law</u> requires advertisements for leased land be published in the official journal of the parish where the land is situated for a period of not less than 15 days and at least one week during three consecutive weeks.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that each bid for the lease of public lands shall be submitted by hand, registered or certified mail, or electronically.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the submittal of a bid on holidays recognized by the U.S. Postal Service.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that all public entities provide for electronic receipt of bids in accordance with the standards of the governor's office, the division of administration, and the office of technology services, unless the public entity meets certain exceptions.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts public entities with no high speed internet access from <u>proposed law</u> until a time when the public entity does have high speed internet access.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts the following from <u>proposed law</u> requirements:

- (1) Parishes with police juries and populations less than 20,000.
- (2) Cities or municipalities with populations less than 10,000.
- (3) Public entities that are unable to comply with <u>proposed law</u> without securing and expending additional funding.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that public entities have the option of requiring electronic bidding for competitive bids.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires public entities to include all information regarding the advertisement for bids in <u>present law</u>.
