**Abstract:** Transfers authority to regulate cable and video service providers <u>from</u> the secretary of state <u>to</u> the Louisiana Public Service Commission.

<u>Present law</u> requires that all cable and video service providers are subject to the authority and the regulations imposed by the secretary of state. <u>Proposed law</u> transfers authority to regulate cable and video service providers <u>from</u> the secretary of state <u>to</u> the La. Public Service Commission (commission).

<u>Present law</u> requires cable and video service providers to comply with the customer service standards established pursuant to <u>present law</u> (47 CFR 76.309(c)). <u>Proposed law</u> adds a provision to allow the commission to adopt additional standards of customer service.
