Abstract: Prohibits assignment of letter grades to schools or school districts or any other implementation of the school and district accountability system for a school year in which there is a declared natural disaster.

<u>Present law</u> requires the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to provide for a system of accountability for schools and school districts based, in part, on growth in student achievement using a value-added assessment model (VAM). Also requires the assignment of letter grades to schools and school districts.

<u>Present law</u> requires BESE to develop and adopt a policy to invalidate student achievement growth data using VAM for any school year in which there is a natural disaster or any other unexpected event that results in the temporary closure of schools.

<u>Proposed law</u> instead provides that notwithstanding <u>present law</u>, neither BESE nor the state Dept. of Education shall assign a letter grade to any school or school district or in any other way implement <u>present law</u> relative to the school and district accountability system for any school year in which there is a natural disaster or catastrophe declared by the governor.
