Abstract: Dedicates certain gaming revenues to Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) awards.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the collection of certain taxes related to slot machines at horse racing facilities.

<u>Present law</u> requires horse racing facilities to contribute certain slot machine revenues to support the horse breeding industry.

<u>Proposed law</u> reduces the contributions to the horse breeding industry from slot machine revenues by 50% and dedicates the remaining 50% to Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) awards.

<u>Present law</u> for the collection of certain taxes related to video poker machines at horse racing facilities.

<u>Present law</u> requires the owners of the horse racing facilities to pay 20% of the net device revenue to supplement purses for horesemen.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the percentage the owners of the horse racing facilities are required of the net device revenue to supplement purses for horesemen from 20% to 10%. Further dedicates 10% of the net device revenue to Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) awards.
